

Parking is off of Moorside lane near Haworth. GPS location Lat 53.829659, Long -1.986800

From the carpark go back to the main road and just before the road note the signpost showing Bronte Falls 1.5 miles. Cross the road and take the footpath directly opposite. This leads to a kissing gate. Pass this and onto the moor. Follow the path which slowly descends down the hillside eventually joining a path with a wall on the right.



Continue, passing a farm house ruin and down some stone steps to reach the waterfall which is on your left.



Cross the Bronte bridge and take the footpath to the right which climbs steeply up the hillside. Go through the kissing gate built into the wire fence and turn right by the footpath marked Haworth 2.5 miles. After 400 metres or so, bear right and follow the path as it now climbs gently across the hillside and eventually giving views down towards the reservoir. Cross the field ahead to reach a ladder style.



Cross the style and at the next signpost turn right along a gravel track signed Stanbury. Follow the track as it drops down the hillside, crossing a cattle grid to become a tarmac lane. The lane eventually joins the main road to enter the village of Stanbury. Go through Stanbury, passing two public houses on the left. As you leave Stanbury turn right at the signpost marked Oxenhope 2 miles. Take the road across the Lower Laithe Reservoir and climb the hill passing intake Intake Farm and Cemetery Road. Just after the boulder marking Penistone Hill Country Park, turn left along the public footpath. Continue along this path to a signpost where you turn right to then reach the start of your walk
