

Waterfall Walk from The Coach House (2.25 miles)

This walk starts at the cottage. There is a climb shortly after the start but is well worth the effort with lots of interest and some great views.

Leave the cottage through the drive and turn right. Walk up to the traffic lights and turn right (300 metres). Walk for 130 metres and cross the road to now walk up Mill Lane. After 130 metres at a T-junction, turn right onto High Street and after a further 50 metres bear left onto Barrows Lane. Walk up Barrows Lane, and this is a bit of a climb, for



some 300 metres and at a footpath sign on the left leave the road on the left to climb a few steps onto a footpath. Follow the path as it leads you through a wood beside a pretty beck, to pass under a viaduct. As you approach the end you will see a number of waterfalls.

Once you reach the end re-trace your steps for a short distance and take the path leading upwards now on your left. Follow this path up to a road. Cross the road and turn left to pass through some iron gates between two stone pillars and onto a drive. Follow the drive for a short distance until you meet a five-bar gate between two pillars. Turn left (then right) to follow the footpath which now goes between the wall on your right and a wire fence on your left. Pass the building on your right to meet a gravel drive and turn right onto it. Walk then between some houses and bear left to walk in front of them on a concrete drive. At the end of the concrete roadway go up a few stone steps and onto a narrow path, shortly pass through the gap in a dry stone wall. Now downhill as you pass through a wood.



Pass over another dry-stone wall and stay with the path as it works its way fairly steeply down hill through the wood.



When you reach an iron kissing gate, pass through it and walk diagonally left towards a point approximately 70 metres from the right hand end of the field. Pass through another gate and onto a road. Go straight across the road and through another kissing gate and walk down towards another obvious road 70 metres or so ahead. Pass through a kissing gate and onto the road and turn right.



Walk back along the pavement for approximately 1 kilometre to reach the traffic lights at the top of Station Road, turn left to re-trace your steps to the Coach House
